VISITORS TO SCHOOLS

It is the policy of the Board to encourage parents and other citizens of the system to visit classrooms to observe the work of the school. The Board believes that there is no better way for the public to learn what the school is actually doing.

All visitors shall report to the school office immediately upon entering all school campuses and report to the administration to obtain authorization to visit any location on the campus. Any other presence on school campus is trespassing. Authorization from the administration is required in order to preserve the safety of students and staff members.

Unauthorized persons shall not be permitted in school buildings or on school grounds. School principals shall take appropriate action to prevent unauthorized persons from entering buildings and from loitering on grounds. If such unauthorized persons do not leave upon demand by school administrators or staff, law enforcement officials should be called immediately to arrest and remove such trespassers.
